

**Revised BYOT Policy:**

Due to the availability of Chromebooks for every student, our BYOT policy has been adjusted accordingly.

Students are still allowed to have cell phones on campus; however, they are only to be used for daily instruction

purposes when requested to do so by their teacher. Starting at 8:45 am, cell phones should be turned-off and

either placed in the student's locker or bookbag and should remain out of site throughout the day. Students are

permitted to use ear buds with Chromebooks as requested by the teacher for instructional use, but not to listen

to music. Please note that students may still use personal laptops, netbooks, iPads, tablets, ereaders, and a

Nook/Kindle as part of BYOT, so long as these devices are being used for instruction. If a student has their cell

phone or other device out at an inappropriate time, the device will be confiscated and parents /guardians will be

notified to pick up the device from the main office.

***1<sup>st</sup> Violation- Student will be banned from bringing their personal device to school for 1 month.***

***2<sup>nd</sup> Violation- Student will be banned from bringing their personal device for 3 months.***

***3<sup>rd</sup> Violation- Student will be banned from bringing their personal device for the remainder of the year.***
