REQUIRED Graduation Rehearsal...

Where: Bojangle's Coliseum
Date: Thursday, June 9, 2022
Time: 5:30-7:00 pm

- **4:45 pm** - Arrive Time - Free Coliseum Parking
- When Doors Open - **Immediately** enter the Coliseum
- **You will be "wanded" to enter rehearsal**
- **Go down to the "tunnel" and find your place in line.** (Junior Marshals will be there to guide you.)

Reminders:

- Arriving promptly & participating in rehearsal is **mandatory** to participate in the grad ceremony.
- All financial obligations **must be paid** prior to rehearsal to participate in graduation ceremony.
- Arrive on time—**busy traffic time!!**
- No parents or guests allowed in rehearsal - only graduates and staff-your ride waits outside in car.
- TRAVEL LIGHT!! Be hands free if you can.
- Stay **OFF your phone** & pay attention during rehearsal.

Graduation...

Where: Bojangle's Coliseum
Date: Saturday, June 11, 2022
Time: 12:00 pm

Reminders: TRAVEL LIGHT, hands free!!!

- **10:30 am**- Arrive Time - Free Coliseum Parking
- **You will be "wanded" to enter graduation**
- **11:00 am** - Students Must Be In Line
- **Anything you bring in (other than a phone) will be taken, stored, & returned to you when you pick up your diploma.**
- You **MAY NOT** use your phone on the arena floor.
- **NO EARBUDS!** Leave them at home or in the car.
- Your phone must be powered **OFF** for the ceremony!
- If you are caught using your phone on the arena floor, you will not get your diploma that day & are subject to removal from the ceremony.
- **Nothing in your hands!** Find a place for your phone.
- *If you arrive after the processional begins, you will not participate in the graduation ceremony!*
- Tickets are **not** required for guests this year.
- Coliseum doors will open for guests at 11:00 am.
- **For guests needing special assistance:** Disabled, elderly, or other guests needing assistance should be dropped off at the front entrance for assistance. Disability seating in the Bojangle's bowl will be used first. After that area fills, any guest using a wheelchair & one relative will be escorted to the floor level along the back wall.
- Be sure to account for drive time to arrive on time.

Graduate Dress Requirements - A student who violates dress code standards will be prohibited from taking part in graduation exercises (CMS Regulation IKF-R):

- All Graduates
 - Dark Dress Pants - No Khaki color **OR:**
 - Dress or Skirt & Blouse - **Must not show below gown**
 - NO jeans or shorts

- Dress Shirt with Tie
- Dark Dress Shoes or NICE, clean sneakers
- NO boots, flip flops, or casual sandals
- Additional "All Graduates" reminders below.
- All Graduates-No jewelry to be visible **outside** of gown other than "appropriate size" earrings
 - No flowers, ribbons, pins, or any like item on the outside of gown
 - Honor cords from school are the **only** items allowed on the outside of the gown
 - Mortar Boards
 - No decorations
 - Tassel moves from right (non-graduate) to left (graduate)
 - **No purses**, backpacks, fanny packs, or other distractors - *These items will be taken from you if brought into the arena.*
 - No food, drinks, or gum
- **Additional Graduate Reminder:** According to CMS rules, graduates will be escorted off stage & will not receive a diploma if student:
 - Drops pants
 - Streaks
 - Flips
 - Flashes gang signs
 - Makes an inappropriate dance and/or motion
 - Any action toward the microphone to speak
 - Any other action Admin deems inappropriate
- Security measures will include "wanding" guests & purse/camera bag search upon entering the venue.
- No food or drinks are allowed inside the coliseum.
- For safety and security reasons & to keep the focus on our graduates, guests will not be allowed to bring the following items into the graduation:
 - flowers
 - duffel bags, fanny packs, or backpacks
 - gifts
 - banners
 - balloons
 - air horns or noisemakers
- To maintain the solemnity of the occasion:
 - Stand as graduates march into the arena.
 - Show respect for all graduates.
 - Applaud politely for each graduate.
 - Limit cheers so every graduate's name is heard by all attendees.
 - Remain seated during the entire ceremony (*including when taking photographs*).
