Parking Passes are \$25.00 and new pass must be purchased each school year. STUDENTS CAN ONLY PARK IN THE STUDENT PARKING LOT LOCATED BY THE FOOTBALL FIELD ONLY. Vehicles not properly registered or vehicles parked anywhere other than the designated student parking areas will be **"BOOTED"** and a payment of \$50.00 will be required before the boot is removed. (Note replacement stickers will be available for \$20 in the event a car is sold and replaced. Remove it before the sale and bring it to us with the \$20 payment. Unfortunately we cannot issue extra stickers for multiple cars in one family, due to previous issues with students transferring them illegally and to help us maintain security in the parking lot).

REQUIREMENT TO OBTAIN A CHAMBERS' HIGH SCHOOL PARKING PERMIT:

"All Student Financial Obligations must be paid.

" Completed Parking Permit Application (signed by both the student and parent/guardian)

" Copy of NC Driver's License

" Copy of Vehicle Registration Card for the car the student will be driving

" Copy of a valid proof of insurance

Parking by students on the campus of Chambers High School is a privilege, not a right; and in consideration thereof, students must abide by following terms and conditions.

Student and parent must initial each term of the contract.

Policy:

____ **Student must have no outstanding school financial obligations. All Student Financial Obligations must be paid first.**

____ Student must be considered a Sophomore, Junior or Senior at the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year.

____ Student may purchase a parking permit if he/she is a licensed driver as a Sophomore, Junior or Senior for that person's vehicle only.

____ Student who purchases or attempts to purchase a permit for another student will have his/her permit revoked and face disciplinary action.

____ Parking permits are non-transferable.

____ Parking permits cost \$25.

____ Registered Chambers High School parking permit must be attached in the lower left hand corner of the vehicle windshield.

____ Parking is permitted only in numbered parking spaces. Illegally parked cars and those without permits will be fined \$25 for each offense and/or be "Booted" or towed from campus AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

____ Cars parked in areas off Chambers campus are subject to towing by property owners.

____ Driving across grass/dirt areas is a \$50 fine and parking permit will be permanently revoked.

____ Student agrees to obey all state and local motor vehicle laws.

____ Student understands that he/she must be wearing a seat belt when operating or riding in a vehicle on school grounds.

____ If student parks a vehicle without displaying a sticker in his or her assigned space, the student must obtain a temporary parking pass from the front office or he or she will receive a parking ticket.

____ If a student receives a parking ticket for any reason, he or she has one week to protest/appeal the ticket before it becomes final.

Discipline Issues

____ Leaving campus or visiting your car (during school hours) without proper authorization may result in the loss of parking privileges.

____ **Student Code of Conduct infractions may result in the loss of parking privileges.**

____ Student Code of Conduct infractions by passengers may result in the loss of their and **your** parking privileges (**You** are responsible for the conduct of your passengers once they are in your vehicle).

____ Driving to school is a privilege. Inherent in that privilege is the responsibility to arrive at school on time and attend classes regularly. **Students consistently tardy in the mornings will lose this privilege after six tardies in a quarter, and you will lose your parking privileges if you are absent ten or more times from a class during the semester without an approved excusal for those absences.**

____ Students parking in the teacher's parking lot or in the visitor's parking spots will lose their current or future parking privileges.

____ Reckless driving, as well as the playing of loud or inappropriate music and non-compliance of an adult directive while on campus, may result in the loss of parking privileges.

____ Vehicles of students who have lost their driving privileges but choose to still park on campus will be ticketed/towed at the owner's expense.

____ Student acknowledges his/her understanding that if he/she leaves school without permission and returns to the school during the school day, the driver and all passengers will be searched.

____ Student agrees that he /she will not bring onto school grounds or keep in his/her vehicle while on school grounds any (including but not limited to); gun, explosive, blackjack, alcohol, drugs, weapon, tobacco, e-cigarettes, chemical or biological agent, or contraband. Permanent revocation of parking permit will occur if any of the aforementioned items are found in the student's vehicle.

____ Student acknowledges his/her understanding that school authorities have the right to open, enter, and search his/her vehicle and remove any unauthorized articles as described in previous item, or any other articles that may endanger health, welfare, or safety of students and school personnel. Any such articles may be retained and used as evidence in disciplinary proceedings by school authorities, or delivered to appropriate law enforcement officials at the sole discretion of the school authorities. Permanent revocation of parking permit will result if any such items are found in the student's car.
