This information is available in the guidance office. We meet monthly as a School Leadership Team to discuss issues that may be occurring at the school. We have parent involvement in our SLT. Our staff communicates with parents on a regular basis and has invited parents into the classroom. Volunteer opportunities are shared through Connect Ed and also through teacher letters home.

We have delivered and will continue to deliver programs focusing on our ELL students and parents. This will remain a focus for our school. We also will be doing ongoing teacher PD to discuss how to talk to
