IBMYP Community Service Guidelines

REQUIREMENTS: 9th GRADE, 35 HOURS 10th GRADE, 40 HOURS

All activities should be recorded in this booklet. An adult supervisor must sign for each activity. If the adult signs a letter or other document, attach it to the appropriate entry page. Turn booklets in by May 15.

Check the CAS bulletin board and listen for announcements of opportunities. Go to volunteermatch.org and put in your zip code for opportunities in the Charlotte area. Check HandsOnCharlotte.org, ugive.org, or waystohelp.org.

Think about the elderly in your neighborhood--is there something they need done (mowing grass, cleaning a shed or pantry, etc.)?

Many school clubs participate in community service, so join clubs and document those hours!

RULE: You cannot receive money, a grade, or class credit for a CAS activity, nor can the activity help someone make a profit.

- if there is a personal gain (e.g., a carwash to raise money so that you or the members of your group can go on a field trip), the activity does not qualify as CAS hours.
- If the activity provides benefit within your circle of personal friends and family (e.g., babysitting free for your sister or neighbor, tutoring your friend), it also does not qualify.
- Church activities can count as CAS hours if they benefit people in the community (e.g., singing Christmas carols at a nursing home), but not if they only benefit church members (e.g., singing at Sunday worship services). Time spent in praise or worship cannot count as CAS.
- Helping a family member at work can count as CAS hours if the employer is a not-for-profit organization (e.g., helping at a Red Cross blood drive), but not if the employer is for-profit (e.g., helping file papers at an insurance company office).

If in doubt, check with the Magnet Coordinator before you spend many hours on an activity.
