Action Taken:

Teacher Turnover - What are the stats for 2021-2022? How many teachers are returning? How many teachers are leaving? What are the staffing needs for 2021-2022?

Summer School - How many HUHS students have enrolled for summer school? What subjects will be taught? What will the staffing be for summer school?

Incoming Freshmen (9th graders) - How will these students be supported, especially those who have EOG scores of 1 and 2? How will these students be supported in Math I? Likewise for ELA, how will these students be supported in English I?

Responses:

Currently, there are 6 teacher vacancies for next year. 2 English, 1 French, 1 Advance Manufacturing (will not have students assigned until Jan 2022), 1 Business Ed, 1 Science. (108.5 teaching staff size) Have opportunity for over-hires in the event a teacher leaves. Ten (10) other hires made for upcoming school year (transfers, etc.)

Watson - Band Director?

Ward -(Communication audio issue)

JA Responding for Ward- Looking for new band director - Cox has begun with outreach to some HBCUs. Feeder schools do not have music programs and we are in need of an appropriate person for this large undertaking.

Watson - North Ridge - has music program and feeder school.

JA - 1st year in this and typical do not have students going through middle school program starting instruments in the 6th grade. Wilson does not come to us.

Watson - Area for an attraction factor at Harding.

Ward - Yes but must start at middle school. Conversation with District and fine arts director. Want to beef these programs up for middle school and summer programs if interest is there.

Watson - Plug for North Ridge and child has benefited from this program. Director is an HBCU graduate.

Summer School - approximately 640 students are enrolled in all three summer programs (9th grade bridge, (240) credit recovery, Summer Prep Academy). Still looking for a Math 3 teacher

Bridge - Math, English, PE, Science, SEL

Credit Recovery - varies (all online) (non - EOC)

Summer Prep Academy - Math 1, Math 3, Biology, English 2, Adobe, ACT Prep, Marketing, Strength/Conditioning

*Ward - Dr. Foggies handled staffing and all are hired.

Watson - Strength and conditioning - working with students in these courses

Ward - These are electives.

Support for EOCs - Will be supported through placement and targeted instruction from EIT (extended impact teachers) and Master Teacher model, double blocked courses, after-school tutorials, Saturday tutorials. "Better Lesson Training" for all Math 1 teachers and EOC team leads, Also refer to strategies listed in the SIP

Math 1, II, II, English I, II, III, IV

Watson - Double blocked courses

Ward - More time for students to complete the course.

Watson - Ellis asking question in Chat - Will math be using Open Up?

Ward - will check on what adoption was.

Ellis - Concern about students coming from Wilson and coming into classes. Looked at EOG courses and teachers did not do a lot of work.

Ward - Had looked at these scores as well as Foggie

Ellis - A lot of work has to be done.

Ward - students did not have an EOC last year and looking at grade-level proficiency and looking at if they are in better shape.

Ellis - In better shape this year!

Watson - Accolades to Ellis for dedication to math. Accolades to Wingate for recent accomplishments (Ph.D).

Wingate - Dr. Ward and self have been working on their Doctorate Programs as well as Dr. Foggie.

Blessing, difficult and thankful for continuous encouragement from others. Appreciation to Ms.

Mason.
