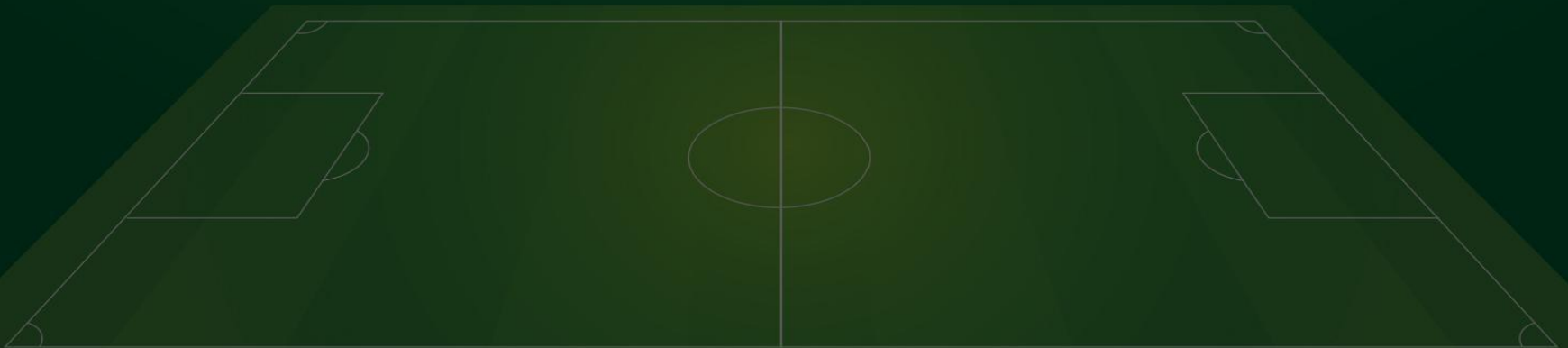

# Title I

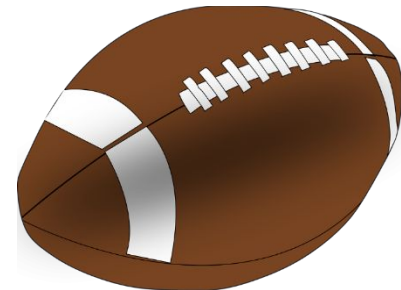
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# Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI)

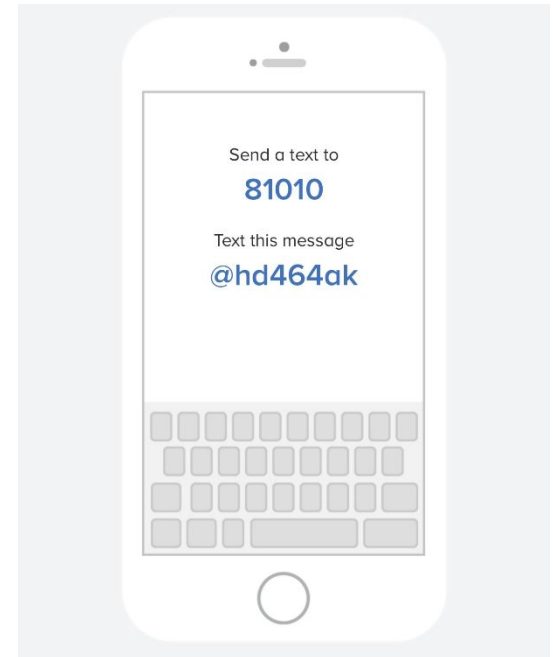
