



REQUIRED END-OF-YEAR TESTING

Dear MOIA Parents or Guardian,

As we approach the end of the school year, we would like to share information with you regarding the expectations for students to participate in end-of-year testing. Unlike spring 2020, all students are expected to take the following state tests, as required by federal and state laws:

- End-of-grade tests in Reading, Mathematics (grades 3-8)
- Science (grades 5)

The end of year testing window is May 12-May 28, 2021

All state and federal assessments are required to be administered in-person, at school. Unfortunately, it is not possible to have students take these assessments at home. Please make every effort to have your child at school on time on days that this test is being administered (by 8:00am), receive plenty of sleep and a good breakfast before testing which increases student performance. Your child will take their assessment in their homeroom classroom. The well-being of our students, teachers, and communities are the highest priority, our schools will work to ensure all health, and safety protocols are in place.

We understand there may be concerns about students who are currently enrolled in the Full Remote Academy coming to school to take an assessment. Please consider the value of having information on your student's learning for this school year, particularly in planning for instruction next year.

Bus transportation will be provided for our Full Remote Academy scholars on their test day. Please let your teacher know by Friday, May 7th if you will be sending your child in on their testing day. We will then contact you with bus information if you need transportation.
