What is the SIT?

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The Purpose of the SIT

- ❑ Facilitates the involvement of the school community in the development of the School Improvement Plan
- ❑ Encourages, supports and creates opportunities for involvement from parents in the community
- ❑ Contributes to the design of the School Improvement Plan
- ❑ Monitors the effectiveness of the School Improvement Plan strategies





Who is on the SIT?

- Minimum: 10
- Maximum: 15
- 50% Families, 50% Staff
- Reflective of School Community
- Elected/Confirmed





The School Improvement Plan

Aligned to CMS Goals and Guardrails

- ❑ **Local/State Required Goals**
 - ❑ *All schools will continue to have these in their plan in accordance with local and state legislature.*
- ❑ **Duty-free planning:** Provide a duty-free instructional planning time for every teacher under G.S.115C-105.27 and -301.1, with the goal of providing an average of at least five hours of planning time per week, with the maximum extent that the safety and proper supervision of students may allow during regular student contact hours. (Aligns to A2.04)
- ❑ **Duty Free Lunch:** To provide a duty-free lunch period for every teacher on a daily basis. (Aligns to A4.06)
- ❑ **Bullying Prevention:** Provide a positive school climate, under CMS regulation JICK-R, by promoting a safe learning environment free of bullying and harassing behaviors. (Aligns to A4.06)





Literacy Goal

- ❑ The percent of Black and Hispanic 3rd grade students combined who score at the College and Career Ready (CCR) level -- a 4 or 5 -- on the English Language Arts (ELA) EOG will increase from 9.4% in SY2021-22 to 29.7% in SY2022-23 and 50% in SY2023-24.





Growth Goal

- ❑ We will meet or exceed expected Educator Value Added Assessment System (EVAAS) growth for our overall school index in SY2022-23 and SY2023-24.





Student Well-being Goal

- ❑ The percent of students reporting a positive self-perception of their self-efficacy, self-management, and/or engagement will increase from 61% on the Fall 2021 Panorama Screener (in Grades 3-5) to 66% in SY2022-23 and 71% in SY2023-24.





Student Well-being Goal

- ❑ Maintain the proportionality of our Out-of-School Suspension (OSS) data for Black students at 0% in SY2022-23 and SY2023-24.
