- 1) Approval of May Minutes
- 2) Scores Report
 - a. Unofficial Copy (GLP = Grade Level Proficiency #3,4,5; CCR = College & Career Readiness, #4,5)
 - i. School Total GLP up 2.3; CCR up 2.9
 - ii. 6th grade reading GLP -.3; CCR -1.1
 - iii. 7th grade reading GLP -9.7; CCR -9.8
 - iv. 8th grade reading GLP +1.3; CCR +3.1
 - v. 8th grade science GLP +8.3; CCR +10.6 (moved room, PLC with Piedmont)
 - vi. Reading Composite GLP -2.5; CCR -3.5

 - f. Number of out of school suspensions was down by 7.8% but number of students with OSS went up 9.1%
 - g. Number of in-school suspensions was down by 57.5% as well as the number of students down by 51.1%
