2. Social media concerns – Meeting held with students 10/30/18 with cyber team and zone superintendent with Q & A, recommendation to students - do not engage in responding to other social media sites.
3. Campus Security:
  - a. Practice Lockdown on 11/2/18 – no longer allowed to pre-announce fire drills and lockdown drills, principal is advising parents to not contact students and meet where advised away from school, students should have phones off.
  - b. Concerns about fencing campus – a fence would not allow students to run to safety off campus.
  - c. We have one Campus Security Associate (CSA) and one school resource officer (SRO).
  - d. Safety Committee to convene with Dean of Students, Mr. C. Edwards, and chaired by A. Currie
  - e. Parent recommendation – have the conversation with the students and include informing parents, **when drills occur include a ConnectEd to inform parents that it is a drill at the same time using the scheduling function of ConnectED.**
  - f. Department Chairs were called to a meeting to inform the staff
  - g. Students found cyberbullying – suspend, ISS, Title 9 re-training
  - h. Students cannot be removed from NWSA due to behavior, may be removed for failing major, Personalized Education Plan (PEP) must also be in place
