A hands-on environmental science competition
for middle and high school students



Envirothon is a middle school and high school Environmental Science curriculum competition. Teams are comprised of five members. The team members study: soils/land use, aquatic ecology, forestry, wildlife and current environmental issues during the school year.

In the spring, there are eight regional competitions in North Carolina. Our region will host the **Southern Piedmont Envirothon** competition on March 14-15, 2017 at the Center for the Environment at Catawba College in Salisbury, NC. A written test is administered to select the top 7 middle school and top 7 high school (and top FFA team) teams to advance to the **State Envirothon** competition on April 29-30, 2017 at Cedarrock Park in Burlington, NC.

One winning high school team from the State Envirothon competition will advance to the **2017 North American Envirothon** on July 23 - 29, 2017 at Mount St. Mary's University in Emmitsburg, Maryland. For more details, please visit www.envirothon.org.

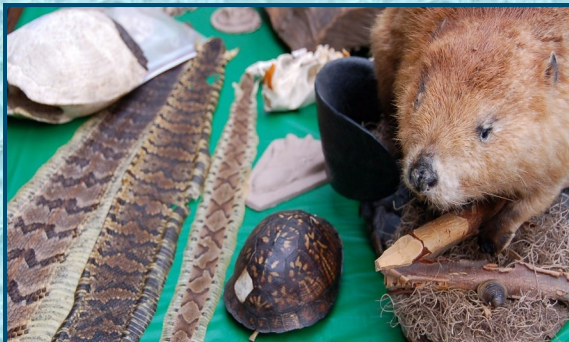
