

CMS COVID-19 Grading Guidelines

Elementary (K-5)

- No grades will be given to students.
- Teachers will provide written feedback about progress on specific standards and content.
- Feedback is in lieu of grades.
- In order to prepare for next year, assignments and activities will continue to be provided and are encouraged to be completed.

Middle (6-8)

- Student remote learning work is being assessed by teachers and used to determine improvement & progress.
- Students receive PC19 (Pass) or WC19 (Withdrawal) based on performance.
- For Semester 2 high school courses for credit (4x4 and yearlong), there is a choice of PC19, WC19, or a final numeric grade.
- Final grades will not count toward GPA.

High (9-11)

(plus rising grade 13 & middle school students taking high school courses for credit)

- Semester 1 grades for all courses (4x4 or year-long) will remain intact and count in the GPA.
- Students will have a choice for how their 2nd semester final grade is recorded on their transcript (4x4 and year-long).
- Students will choose between a PC19 (Pass), WC19 (Withdraw), or their earned numeric grade for each Semester 2 course (for yearlong courses if Semester 2 is higher grade than Semester 1, the higher grade will be recorded for both semesters).

Seniors

- Semester 1 grades for all courses (4x4 or year-long) will remain intact and count in the GPA.
- Students will receive a PC19 (Pass) or WC19 (Withdraw) based on their learning as of Quarter 3.
- If students had an 'F' as of Quarter 3 for graduation requirements, students will be given learning opportunities to improve to a passing grade throughout the remainder of the year.
