Math -

In math we are beginning our unit on data. Data is a fancy term for graphs and information. We will create graphs using tally marks and pictures. We will learn to read the graphs and answer questions based on the information in the graph. We will move into place value halfway through the month. Students will be able to create a 10, count by tens. They will identify the tens and ones place. They will be able to add using tens and ones. We will also work on our numbers to 120. We will be counting on and finding which number is next.

Science and Social Studies

We will work on Social Studies for December. We are learning about other cultures. We will be comparing languages, celebrations and food of different parts of the world. We will compare Chinese New Year, Arabic Ramadan, Navajo Indians and many others. You can help your child by discussing your culture.
