Literacy - Recognizing the first set of letters & their sounds (s, a, t, p, i, n) .

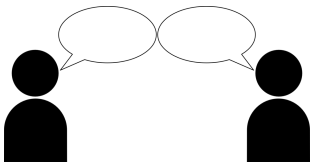
Math - Counting to 10 and basic shapes

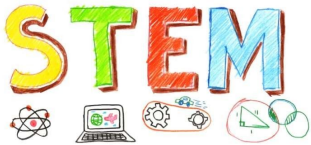
Vocabulary Challenge

Science Technology Engineering and Math Activity

Build a Penny Bridge

Find out just how strong a bridge you can build from simple materials! Using paper index cards, kids will get their civil engineering on as they build several different bridges and load them with pennies to test their relative strength. What happens when they add some tape to their designs, or combine more than one shape. Use different types of paper and fold in different ways to create a bridge between two objects just as a stack of books or blocks.
